- Only one application is needed per family, so please include all children enrolled in Diocesan schools.
- Stewardship Application is due by the following:

October 31, 2024 | Families with Returning CGHS Student(s) January 8, 2025 | Families with a New CGHS Students(s) March 1, 2025 | All Other Families

Criterion I: St. Michael Church Membership

Be a Fully Registered Member of St. Michael

 - Fully registered families include one baptized Catholic adult or have entered the church via the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA).
 - Parent/Guardian(s) are required to send the reception of sacramental information with Dates/Church/Location to Stewardship@stmcary.org.

Identifiable treasure donations

- We humbly ask for a history of giving to our church offertory, and if able, please consider also financially supporting our parish school, ie. Endowment, Tuition Assistance Fund, or/and our PTO.
 - Sign up for online giving on Realm, https://onrealm.org/StMichaelArchangel/Account/Start
 - Realm is where you can find your giving history for your applications.
 - If you prefer you can request offertory envelopes; however, it may take 6 weeks for the envelopes to arrive. In the meantime, you may turn in an envelope with your full name, address, and phone number to be attributed to your account.
- As a non-profit institution, we rely on the generosity of parishioners and school families to sustain and maintain our thriving parish school and our greater St. Michael community.
