Father's Faith Note

My Dear People,

Our gospel for this Sunday perhaps contains some of the hardest teachings of Jesus. To love our enemies, to do good to those who hate us, to bless those who curse us, and pray for those who mistreat us, is surely hard. These things go against our hardwired self-protective instincts to love enemies and to do good to those who wish us ill. When we are struck, our nervous system tells us to fight or flee—and with good reason. God made us this way so that we can avoid harm. Jesus tells us, though, to rise above these reflexes and choose the supernatural path, one we can only hope to achieve with His help. We might fear that the instructions given by Jesus would let us be taken advantage of in this world. However, Jesus calls us not to self-preservation but to live with the radical love and generosity that He will model for us when He washes the feet of His disciples and, in the end, when He lays down His life on the cross.

Given that Chris is coming so close to Lent, we will not have a Lenten Mission in English this year, so take advantage of this opportunity to prepare for the holy season!

FEBRUARY IS BLACK HISTORY MONTH HATTIE CANTY



The following is the final article in our series for Black History Month.

From humble beginnings in rural Alabama to leading one of the most powerful labor unions in Las Vegas, Hattie Canty made history as a fierce advocate for fair wages and working conditions. Rising through the ranks of the Culinary Workers Union, she became its first Black female president, fearlessly leading strikes and securing better futures for workers in the hospitality industry.

Her work extended beyond labor rights—Canty’s efforts bridged the fight for civil rights and women’s empowerment, transforming lives and communities. The Culinary Academy of Las Vegas, which she helped establish, continues her legacy of lifting others up.

Did you know that St. Michael started a **Security Team** in 2018? This dedicated team of **30 members** helps ensure the **safety** and **security** of our parish by locking doors, turning off lights after events, and assisting at special events or large gatherings.

RED NAME BADGES – YOUR SECURITY TEAM AT MASS

Team members will now wear **red name badges** during Mass. These individuals are here to help with any situation or answer your questions. Many of them are current or retired law enforcement, firefighters, and EMS professionals, though anyone calm in emergencies and willing to learn is welcome to join.

AUXILIARY SECURITY TEAM

In situations that require extra coverage—such as **campus protection** during major events or Eucharistic Adoration—the **Auxiliary Security Team** steps in as backup. This group doesn’t wear red badges but supports the primary team when needed.

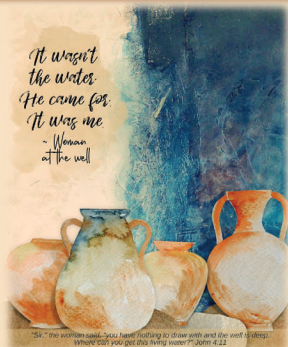

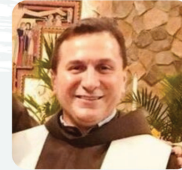
